Collections may be cancelled in the event of bad weather. Door-to-door collections are reserved for normal household activity waste.



Sort your **paper** and **cardboard** in a jiffy!




Comments:



Remove the plastic film from publications.

Put your paper and cardboard in cardboard boxes, tightly closed and weighing no more than 15 kg.





What does the Green Dot logo mean? The Green Dot logo on packaging indicates that the company that places the product on the market contributes to the financing of the selective collection, sorting and recycling of household packaging. It says nothing about the recyclability of the product or its packaging and it is not a sorting rule.

Flatten plastic bottles, replace the cap.



Remove the plastic film from the tray and discard them separately in the bag.



Remove the plastic film that covers the entire bottle and dispose of it separately in the blue bag.

CAUTION!



Do not put any packaging inside other packaging and do not group it together in tied up bags (leave it loose in the bag).



Don't attach anything to the outside of the bag.
